REQUEST

Information is sought from **every NHS/HSC Trust or Health Board in the UK** which has treated children with Kawasaki Disease in the last 13 years. We have considered the request below in the context of ensuring this is a manageable FOI seeking proportionate information within the time parameters allowed per organisation, for processing and completing an FOI request. **Please note that the information requested does not constitute personally identifiable data and has been provided for previous periods by over 80 NHS Trusts in England.** It is therefore possible for NHS Trusts to provide this. I have been in touch with Information Commissioner's Office who have confirmed that the request below is valid and can be dealt with by Trusts/Health Boards under the FOI Act.

Request for Information:

Kawasaki Disease affects a growing number of children and young people in the UK. It is the leading cause of acquired heart disease in children. No national records exist of patient numbers and this FOI seeks to establish essential data for this patient population.

For your Trust, please provide, per calendar year for the period January 2006 to December 2018 inclusive, the following information for each admission of Kawasaki Disease - ICD10 diagnosis (primary or secondary) of M303 Mucocutaneous lymph node syndrome:

- **Year of each admission**
- **Month of each admission**
- **Patient gender**
- **Patient ethnicity**
- **Age of patient at diagnosis**
- **First four items of patient postcode (partial postcode which is non-identifiable)**
