REQUEST

The BBC would like to make the following request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

The number of admissions to the Accident and Emergency Department for trampoline related injuries, during the following periods:

2011-2012
2012-2013
2013-2014
2014-2015
2015-2016
2016-2017 (to date)

If you have the information, please can you detail the kind of injury sustained eg. Head injury or spinal injury.

RESPONSE

The Trust does not record 'trampoline related injuries' on any of its clinical systems. All trampoline injuries would simply be recorded as 'minor injury – limb, torso, head', etc.

In order for the Trust to provide the information requested; a manual search of all records which contained the 'minor injury' recording would be required.

Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act St Helens & Knowsley Teaching Hospitals Trust does not have to comply with a request if we estimate that the cost of complying with your request would exceed the appropriate limit of £450. The appropriate limit has been specified in regulations. This represents the estimated cost of one person spending 2½ working days in answering the remainder of your questions. Under section 12 of the Freedom of Information Act the Trust is not obliged to comply with your request and we will not be processing your request further.
