## REQUEST

We are urgently seeking comparative data on 2013/14 hospital acquired MRSA bacteraemia for Burns Units across the country. All figures for MRSA bacteraemias should be the same cases that have been declared to the Health Protection Agency (HPA).

Specifically please provide the following for the period April 2013-March 2014 inclusive:

- Number of HPA reported hospital acquired MRSA bacteraemia cases in your Burns Unit where hospital stay for patient attributed to either of burns care related national specialties (National treatment function code either 161, 160, 219 or 220).
- Number of admitted care spells in your Burns Unit, where spell attributed to either of burns care related national specialties (National treatment function code either 161, 160, 219 or 220).
- Number of beddays associated to admitted care spells in your burns unit, where spell attributed to either of burns care related national specialties (National treatment function code either 161, 160, 219 or 220).

## RESPONSE

The corporate information team is unable to respond to question 1

- Number of admitted care spells in your Burns Unit, where spell attributed to either of burns care related national specialties (National treatment function code either 161, 160, 219 or 220).

There were 369 spells.

- Number of beddays associated to admitted care spells in your burns unit, where spell attributed to either of burns care related national specialties (National treatment function code either 161, 160, 219 or 220).

The total spell length of stay for the above spells was 2,402.
