Additionally, under the Freedom of Information Act 200 I require the names (or GMC numbers) of all consultants working within the Adult & Paediatric A&E department during March, April & May 2018 even if they no longer work at the Trust, including substantive and locum posts (please show this by month)

RESPONSE

We unable to provide information you required relating to the names (or GMC numbers) of all consultants working within the Adult & Paediatric A&E department during March, April & May 2018 as releasing this information could lead to the identification of the individuals in question. This would constitute personal information and would be considered exempt under Section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act. Section 40 (FOI Act) provides an exemption to disclosure, where disclosure would contravene any of the Data Protection principles. This exemption is an absolute exemption that is not subject to the public interest test. Where the information relates to an individual who can be identified from that data, or from that data when added to other information, in the possession of, or likely to come into the possession of the data controller, this meets the definition of personal data as defined by the Data Protection Act.
