Accommodation

1. Is accommodation available for junior doctors? Where is it located?
2. What is the cost of a single room for a junior doctor per month?

Public transport

1. Bus / Train
The Trust has a free shuttle bus which operates between the St Helens and Whiston sites.

Food and drink

1. The Trust has a restaurant and coffee outlet on each site which offer a selection of hot and cold food.
2. The staff restaurant at Whiston hospital is open from 8am to 8 pm every day.
The staff restaurant at St Helens hospital is open from 8am to 2.30pm Monday to Friday.

The coffee outlet at Whiston is open 06:45-18:30 M-F and 09:00-17:00 Sat-Sun.

The coffee outlet at St Helens is open 08:00-18:00 M-F and 08:00-14:00 Sat

3. The Trust has 18 vending machines which provide a selection of hot and cold food 24/7.

Accommodation

1. Residential accommodation is available for junior doctors, this is located off site.
2. Current rental charges are £595 p.c.m. (which includes utilities).

Library

1. There is a library on the Whiston hospital site.
2. The library is located within the Education and Training Department.
3. The doctors can gain entry via the access control point which is activated using their ID badge.
