Following your visit today to the Buchanan Suite, you require further investigation. This is usually done by measuring levels of pregnancy hormone in your blood. You will be advised to attend for a blood test on a specified day.

You will be informed by the staff in the Buchanan Suite when to return or contact the clinic for results.

You will be discharged from the clinic when all the tests have been completed.

Until that time a definite diagnosis cannot be reached and an Ectopic Pregnancy (a pregnancy growing outside your womb) could be a possibility.

During this period of investigation if you experience any of the following symptoms it is important that you seek medical advice immediately:

Abdominal pain	Shoulder tip pain	Pain in back passage
Fainting or dizzy spells	Vaginal bleeding	Generally feeling unwell
